ORDER

- 1. This is an application under Section 439 Cr PC seeking regular bail in FIR No. 313 of 2013 registered at Police Station Kalyan Puri under Sections 304B, 498A, 302, 34 IPC.
- 2. The Petitioner has been in judicial custody since 14th May 2013. The charges have been framed on 21st September 2013.
- 3. Ms. Aashaa Tiwari, learned APP for the State confirms that out of 26 prosecution witnesses, 12 have been examined which includes all the public witnesses.

4. It is seen that the trial is unlikely to be concluded at an early stage.

The Court finds that the bail application itself is pending since 20th May 2014.

5. In the circumstances, the Court directs that the Petitioner shall be released subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000 with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court and subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The Petitioner will furnish to the trial Court his current address and mobile contact details and will not shift from the said address without permission of the trial Court.
- (ii) The Petitioner will appear on every date before the trial Court;
- (iii) The Petitioner will not interfere with the fair progress of the trial;
- (iv) If any of the above conditions is not adhered to, the prosecution can apply for cancellation of the bail.
- 6. The application is disposed of.
 - 7. The trial Court record be sent back forthwith.
- 8. Order be given dasti to learned counsel for the parties under the signature of the Court Master.
