Ms. Srilina Roy, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Ms. Nandita Rao, learned Additional Standing Counsel (Criminal), on instructions from SI Pawan Tomar, Police Station Prashant Vihar, Delhi, states that the respondents shall afford adequate protection to the petitioner herein after assessing the threat perception. The petitioner, who appears in person, agrees to the statement made by Mr. Arya and Mr. Kumar on behalf of the respondents they represent, that he

does not apprehend any harm at the hands of the said respondents at this juncture.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
